

Village of Greene  
Board Meeting January 12, 2026

Mayor DuMond called the meeting to order at 7pm with the Pledge of Allegiance, in attendance were: Trustees Najarian, Storman, McGrath and reappointed Trustee Shapley. Also, present were Sewer Plant Operator Ingraham, Electric Superintendent Livingston, OIC Nordberg, Fire Chief Williams and Working Supervisor Kinney. Visitors: Trenton Drew, Kendrick Baucas and Troy Braman.

Mayor DeMond appointed Pamela Shapley as trustee. Mayor DuMond administered the oath of office. Trustee Shapley signed the written oath of office.

Motion by Trustee McGrath seconded by Trustee Najarian to accept board meeting minutes of 12/8/2025. Ayes-all. Carried.

Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee Shapley that Treasurer's, Police, Town of Greene and Code Enforcement reports were received and filed. Ayes-all. Carried.

Fire Chief Williams stated that the legal ad for Tanker Apparatus bids will be published in the Evening Sun on 1/16/2026 and 1/23/2026. Bids will be due at the Village Office, 49 Genesee St, Greene, NY 13778 by noon on 3/9/2026. Bids will be opened at the Village of Greene board meeting on 3/9/2026, meeting begins at 7 pm.

Motion by Trustee McGrath seconded Trustee Storman to approve the \$5,000.00 for the sale of 2014 inflatable boat, motor and trailer, with the funds of \$5,000 being assigned to Fire Dept Building, Repair & Maintenance Reserve account A.9950.931. Ayes-all. Carried

Electric Superintendent Livingston requested approval to attend 2026 Spring MEUA Engineering and Accounting & Finance Workshops taking place March 10-11, 2026 at the Doubletree Hotel in East Syracuse, NY. Superintendent Livingston requested approval for himself, Kurt Davis, Matt Brewster and Dedra Ingraham. Motion by Trustee Storman seconded by Trustee Najarian for Superintendent Livingston, Kurt Davis, Matt Brewster and Dedra Ingraham to attend 2026 Spring MEUA Engineering and Accounting & Finance Workshops March 10-11, 2026. Ayes-all. Carried. Electric Superintendent Livingston is requesting quotes for ash tree removal.

Work Supervisor Kinney gave an update on salt usage. The village has used the remainder from last winter and had two loads delivered this winter. Orders for two more loads of salt have been placed and currently are taking 2 ½ weeks to arrive. Working Supervisor Kinney reported there is a power steering problem with the Freightliner plow truck. TNR has been on site to access the problem. A power steering pump has been ordered and due to arrive January 13<sup>th</sup>. TNR will make the repairs on site. Working Supervisor Kinney has an outstanding invoice with Monroe

Tractor for skid steer repairs. Working Supervisor Kinney and Monroe Tractor are working to resolve a dispute on the amount due on invoice.

OIC Nordberg requested permission to surplus two computers. Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee Shapley to surplus two computers. Ayes-all. Carried.

Sewer Plant Operator Ingraham reported that the Susquehanna River Basin has completed their inspection, no problems or issues to report. Sewer Plant Operator Ingraham stated this inspection is done every 3 – 5 years.

Fire Protection Contract and Fire Protection Reimbursable Expenses Contract with the Town of Greene for 2026 were signed by Mayor and Trustees of the Village of Greene. Contracts will be given to Town of Greene for signing at January 21<sup>st</sup> meeting.

Motion by Trustee Shapley seconded by Trustee Storman to appoint Lynne Ruth and Kaitlyn Dunlap as election inspectors for Village of Greene elections on March 18, 2026. Ayes-all. Carried.

Deputy Clerk Treasurer read the Resolution introducing a proposed local law repealing and replacing Chapter 53 of the Village Code Entitled “Construction Codes, Uniform”. A public hearing will be held on February 9, 2026 at 7:00p.m. at the Village Hall, 49 Genesee Street, Greene, NY.

Mayor DuMond read a note from Shirley and John Girton thanking the employees of the village for everything they do.

Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee Storman to authorize payments of audited claims in the amount of \$558,675.93.
