

Village of Greene Board Minutes
July 15, 2025 7pm

Mayor DuMond opened the meeting at 7pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. In attendance were Trustees Najarian, McGrath, Shapley and Storman. Also present were: Sewer Plant Operator Ingraham, Superintendent Livingston, OIC Nordberg, Fire Chief Williams, Working Supervisor Kinney arrived late. Visitors: Marcia Miller.

Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee Shapley to accept board meeting minutes of 6/9/25. Ayes-all. Carried.

Motion by Trustee McGrath seconded by Trustee Storman that all the Treasurer's, Police, Town & Village Historian and Code Enforcement reports were received and filed. Ayes-all. Carried.

Fire Chief Williams reported there is now a cell phone for the Fire Dept so whoever is in charge if F.C. Williams is not available, they will get the call without interruption with whoever is on call that evening. Clerk Treasurer will email new number to the Mayor and Trustees.

Superintendent Livingston said they have been busy with the storms that we have been getting lately.

Trustee Storman reported for Working Supervisor Kinney. Highway Dept has been doing sidewalk work. Chips funding will not be forfeited if it is not used this year, it can be rolled over until next year.

OIC Nordberg reported there will be 2 officers on duty for the Craft Fair on 7/26/25 and for the Greene yard sale day 8/9/25 as well.

Sewer Plant Operator Ingraham reported the lead & copper samples came back fine. Also, sewer line survey came back showing some leaks and debris that will be addressed.

Mayor DuMond read a letter from Greene Community Labor Day Picnic Assoc. requesting permission to have their annual Labor Day Picnic on 9/1/25 at 8am.

Motion by Trustee McGrath seconded by Trustee Shapley to grant permission for Greene Community Labor Day Picnic Association to have the annual Labor Day Picnic on 9/1/25 at 8am. Ayes-all. Carried.

Motion by Trustee Shapley seconded by Trustee Najarian to allow Long Haul Homestead to hold their sidewalk market from 9am – 2pm 7/12/25 thru 8/9/25 in front of Resale 41. Ayes-all. Carried.

Clerk Treasurer read the Newton Boyce Trust Fund Resolution authorizing limited administrative support for the Newton Boyce Trust Fund and clarifying responsibilities as well as the memorandum of understanding between the Village of Greene and the Trustees of the Newton Boyce Trust Fund. Resolution passed 5-ayes. 0-nayes. Carried.

Mayor DuMond read Bond Resolution authorizing the acquisition of machinery and apparatus for construction and maintenance and roof repairs to the village electric department building: estimating

that the total cost thereof is \$160,800. This is subject to a 30-day permissive referendum. Ayes-all. Carried. This resolution is under separate cover included in the minute book.

Clerk Treasurer read Bond Resolution authorizing the acquisition of construction and reconstruction of certain electrical distribution system improvements in and for the village: estimating that the total cost thereof is \$57,600. This is subject to a 30-day permissive referendum. Ayes-all. Carried. This resolution is under separate cover included in the minute book.

Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee McGrath to authorize payments of audited claims in the amount of \$144,228.04 as follows:

Electric	\$45,472.25	Sewer	\$33,820.69

Ayes-all. Carried.

Trustee McGrath reported he and Water Dept are continuing meeting with Laberge Engineering concerning the upcoming waterline project. Hydrants at the Ballflats have been replaced.

Trustee Shapley – nothing to report.

Trustee Storman – nothing to report.

Trustee Najarian – nothing to report.

Working Supervisor Kinney reported he will be contacting Chenango County, as he was told Chenango County has no plan on installing curb or sidewalk at the North Chenango Street bridge. He was originally told there would be sidewalk on one side of the bridge and not the opposite side, but now he has been told there will be no sidewalk on either side of the new bridge. He will keep the Trustees and Mayor updated with trying to get the sidewalk installed by the County.

Mayor DuMond opened the floor to visitors-no one spoke.

Motion by Trustee McGrath seconded by Trustee Najarian to exit regular session and enter into executive session at 8pm. Ayes-all. Carried.

Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee McGrath to exit executive session at 8:56pm. Ayes-all. Carried.

Motion by Trustee Najarian seconded by Trustee McGrath to adjourn meeting at 8:57pm. Ayes-all. Carried.
